

**ORDINANCE 2019- 34**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-27 TO NO LONGER EXEMPT SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL NEW CONSTRUCTION FROM THE .20 PER SQUARE FOOT FEE DEDICATED TO THE EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND AND TO INCLUDE EXPANSION TO ALL EXISTING NON-SINGLE FAMILY CONSTRUCTION**

**Whereas**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mt. Juliet desire to amend Chapter 12 Fire Protection and Prevention to amend “Section 12-28 – Adequate Emergency Services Fee”; and

**Whereas**, a fee for the “Adequate Emergency Services Fee” is amended to include all new construction, expansions to existing non-single family, and single family residential construction based on the square footage as shown in Fee Schedule Option A; and

**Now, therefore, be it ORDAINED**, by the City of Mt. Juliet Board of Commissioners, the City of Mt. Juliet City Code, Chapter 12, Fire Prevention and Protection, is now

1. The City of Mt. Juliet establishes an “Adequate Emergency Service Permit Fee” for all new construction in the amount of .20 cents per square foot, as well as a fee of .20 cents per square foot for expansions to existing non-single-family construction. (Calculation is figured on entire square footage)

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**


**Section 1.** In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part hereof, and the whole or part of any existing ordinance of the City, the conflicting ordinance is repealed to the extent of the conflict but no further.

**Section 2.** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law, the public welfare requiring it.


